



FEST - Music Walk With Me (MWWM) is a showcase festival aimed at artists seeking collaboration with the film and TV industry, as well as those already connected with it.

Despite the growing interest in cross-industry partnerships, accessing the world of cinema remains a challenge for many musicians due to limited collaboration between the music and film sectors.

To bridge this gap, FEST created MWWM to provide a platform for artists to showcase their talents and foster connections within the music, film, and TV industries.

Many musicians encounter challenges in distribution,

promotion, and accessing opportunities for collaboration with filmmakers. Limited collaboration between the music and film industries persists due to their perceived separation, resulting in a lack of understanding of each other's needs and challenges. Overcoming these obstacles requires the establishment of platforms, programs, and innovative solutions to foster collaboration and creative opportunities.

Following its successful inaugural edition, FEST - Music Walk With Me is back for a second edition, conceived to showcase music acts from artists eager to collaborate with the film and TV industry or strengthen their existing connections.
